Zambia Airports Corporation Limited

Zambia Airports Corporation Limited is a Public Limited Company which is wholly owned by the Government of Zambia.

It was established in 1989 through an act of Parliament. It is responsible for the development, maintenance and management of the four designated international airports, namely, Kenneth Kaunda (Lusaka), Harry Mwaanga Nkumbula (Livingstone), Simon Mwansa Kapwepwe (Ndola), and Mfuwe and the provision of air navigation services throughout Zambia. The Corporation is mandated to enhance safety and improve standards of service provision at these airports and in the Zambian air space.

The Corporation recognizes that the changing demands of airlines, passengers and the general public can only be met if facilities and services are modernised through refurbishment, rehabilitation, replacement and new construction.

The Corporation is structured in three Divisions namely: Head Office, Airport Services and Air Navigation Services.

Mission: To develop and manage airport and air navigation infrastructure and services to international standards, meeting our stakeholders values while profitably contributing to the national economic development.
