About the Course

The Basic Firefighting & Evacuation Procedures course is designed to provide participants with the knowledge and expertise which will enable them to identify conditions capable of causing a fire, understand the technical skills of controlling and extinguishing a fire using fire suppression equipment. In addition, participants will familiarise themselves with evacuation procedures, understand their roles and responsibilities for a safe and efficient evacuation and be acquainted with the basic principles of inspection and fire risk assessments.

- Know the three elements for a fire to occur.
- Identify the causes of fire.
- Define the classification of fire.
- Name the four different types of fire extinguishers and their extinguishing media.
- Apply the principle of fire extinguishment.
- Choose the appropriate type of fire extinguisher.
- Know how to operate a fire extinguisher.
- Take appropriate actions in case of fire.
- Determine actions to be taken in smoke and fumes conditions.
- Carry out inspections and fire risk assessment.
- Familiarise with evacuation procedures.
- Understand their roles and responsibilities for an efficient and safe evacuation.
